Did you know.....

Built in 1885, Buchanan Elementary School (now known as the Buchanan Center, home of HCCI, Cornerstone of Topeka and Breakthrough House) was one of the segregated schools to serve the African-American community.

This was the segregated school Mrs. Lucinda Todd taught at and her daughter Nancy later attended during the court proceedings in *Brown vs. Board of Education*. Mrs. Todd, as part of the NAACP plan, attempted to enroll her daughter in Randolph Elementary School, which was then a segregated school for white children.

Under President Buchanan, Kansas was admitted into the Union as a free state.

APRIL 25-28—LANDON ARENA

It is a violation of federal law for a housing provider to refuse to rent or sell a home, to offer unequal terms, quote different prices, or apply different policies on the basis of race, color, religion, disability, or handicap, sex, familial status, or national origin. State law prohibits discrimination on the basis of marital status, ancestry, age, or familial status. Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988 bars discrimination in the sale or rental of housing on the basis of a disability or because there are children in the family, but exempts housing for older persons.
